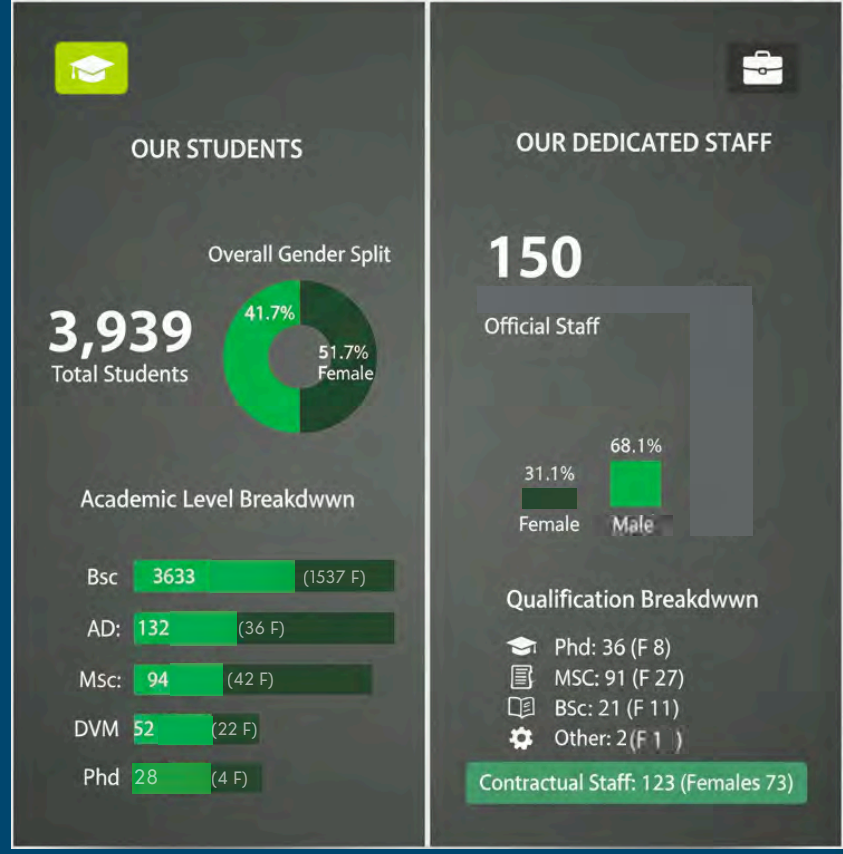

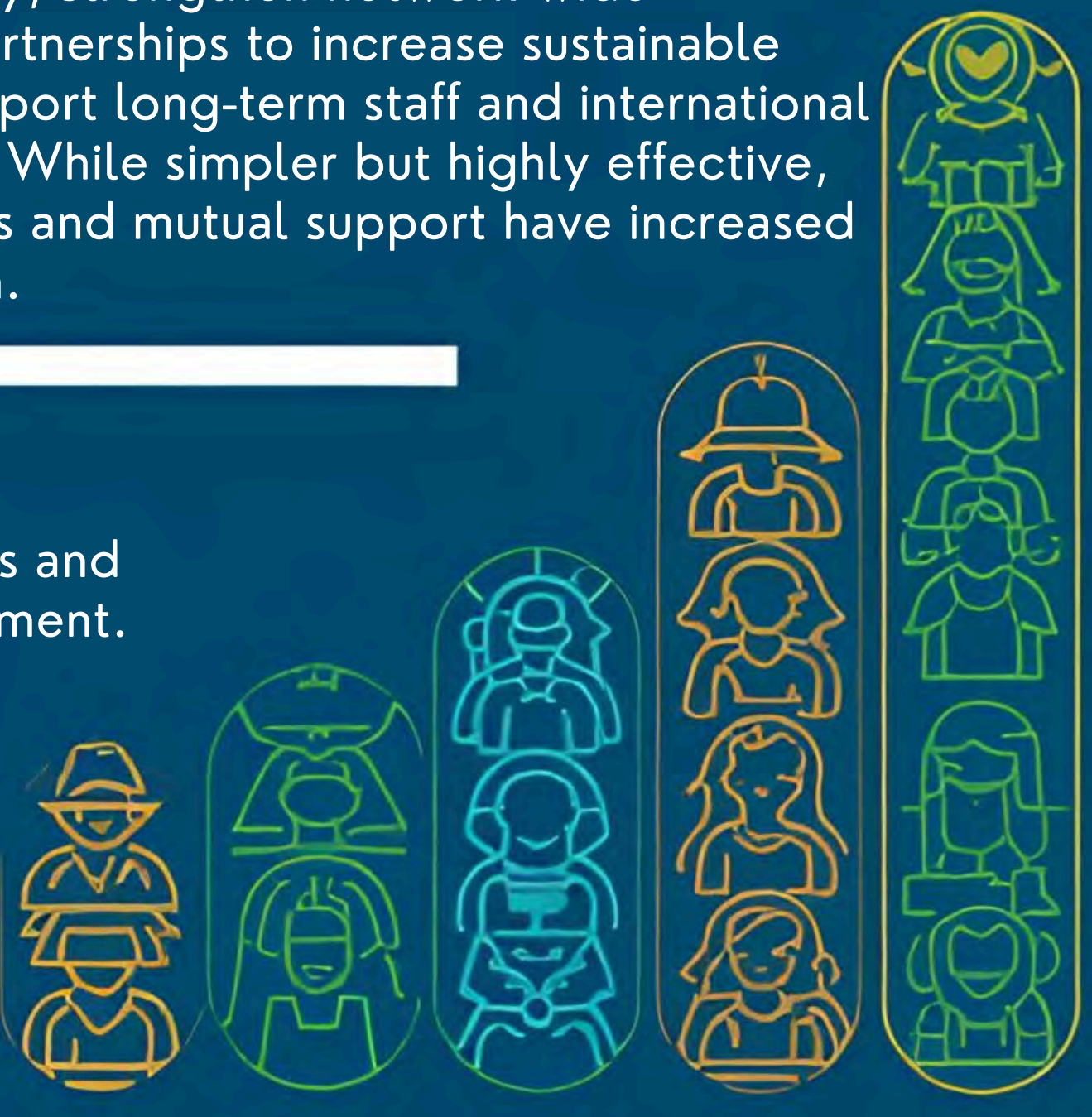


International Relations IRO
