Application:

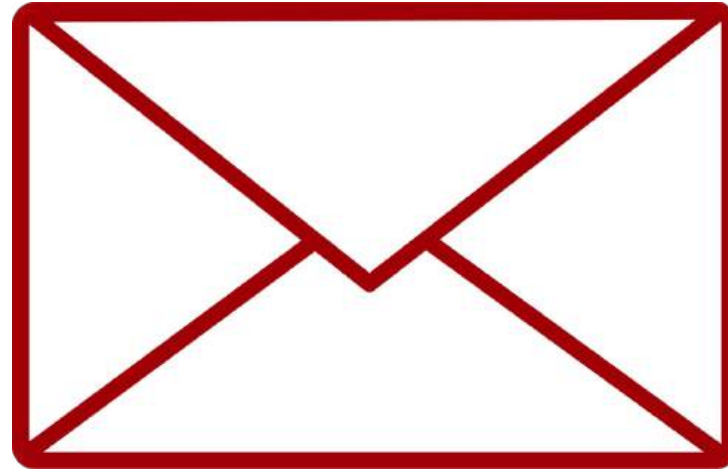
- applications are managed via uni-assist
